

Recycling Policy

Jeff Skinner Skip Hire Limited aim to recycle 100% of the waste found in skips. All our waste is then segregated to improve our recycling figures.

All waste that enters our Transfer Station is deposited into our tipping shed where it is sorted by hand (for the smaller waste) or by machine (for bulk waste) into the designated areas, i.e. Cardboard, paper, metal, bricks, wood, and packaging. Once the waste has being segregated into the designated areas, then loaded into large waste containers and transported to local firms in the area that have the required equipment to reuse that waste type.

The table below details the products we recycle and what it is used for:

<u>Product</u>	<u>Process</u>
Metal	Different metals are segregated and shredded to be reused for Metal products
Wood	Chipboard Manufacturing
Mixed Plastics	Cleaned, shredded and grinded to be reused for Plastic products
UPVC Windows	Recycled
Brick (Including Terracotta tiles)	Crushed and Re – Used as Sub Base
Concrete	Crushed and Re – Used as Sub Base MOT TYPE 1 Product
Subsoil / Topsoil	Used for Land Regeneration
MDF	Waste to Energy (RDF)
Green Waste	Composting
Plaster Board	Stripped, cleaned and then milled into a powder for the production of new plasterboard sheets.
Cardboard	Cartons / Cardboard Boxes
Paper	Tissue making Grades
Tyres	Shredded for use in Playgrounds etc

Unfortunately, some of the waste received cannot be recycled individually but it is sent on to another processing site to be used for RDF (Refuse-derived fuel).
